Road Approach Application Form - Landowner

NO CONSTRUCTION SHALL COMMENCE PRIOR TO THE PRELIMINARY INSPECTION REPORT

In order to build a road approach there must be a signed Access and Work Agreement in place. A deposit of \$1000.00 for an unpaved surface or \$2000.00 for a paved surface is required for each legal land description. A fee of \$75.00 applies to each inspection. Approaches must be marked with survey stakes or GPS coordinates (stakes available at the front counter). After the approach has been built to County standards, the deposit will be refunded less the associated fees (existing/preliminary & final) inspection. The County requires 30 days' notice for preliminary and final inspections. Approaches must be located a minimum of 15.5 meters (50 ft.) from an intersection of two local roads, measured from the closest edge of the approach to the shoulder of the intersecting road. Top of approach must be 9.8 meters (32 ft.) in width. Sight distance must be 183 meters (600 ft.) on an 80 k.p.h. road and 305 meters (1,000 ft.) on a 100 k.p.h. road. Surface of approach is to match the surface of the adjoining roadway. No downhill grades onto county roads. Used culverts are not permitted.
