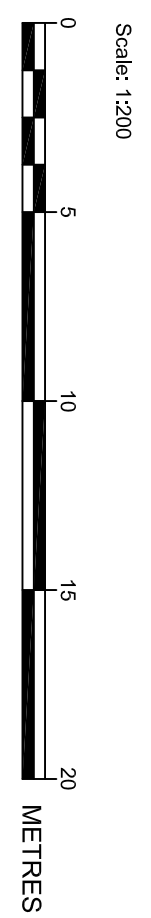
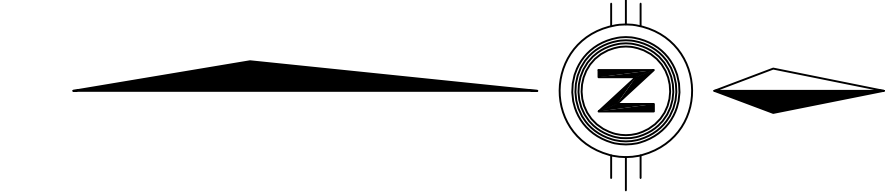


WHEATLAND COUNTY

DIMENSIONS & DESIGNATIONS REGARDING
MONUMENTS, MARKERS AND NICHES

All monument labels must be of granite, marble, field stone or bronze.

All other monument or memorial labels materials proposed to be used must be approved by the Chief Administrative Officer, or designate.

Failure made of glass or any other breakable materials are not allowed to be attached or affixed in any manner whatsoever, to any part of a monument, marker or niche. The responsibility for the appearance of the monument or marker, and the appearance of the monument or marker, or that poses, is the responsibility of the owner. The owner will not be responsible for any damage done to any preexisting monument.

Dimensions of Monuments and Markers:
Maximum of 1200mm of 48 inches in width at the widest part of all blocks.

Maximum of 1200mm of 48 inches in height at the highest part of all blocks.
Taller monuments may be approved at the discretion of the CAO.
The base of all monuments and/or foundations shall be set back 50mm (two inches) from the edge of the concrete runner.

Only the Monuments and/or Foundations shall be set back 50mm (two inches) from the edge of the concrete runner.

On existing grave sites that must remain consistent with the surface of the ground.

Maximum of 600 mm or 24 inches at the horizontal height.

Monuments in the field of honor shall be a standard military upright monument.

DEFINITIONS:

a. Monument means a memorial permanently constructed to extend above the surface of the concrete runner, surface of the ground, or attached on the face of a niche cover.

Section 6. Any monument to be placed in the field of honor shall be set back 50mm (two inches) from the concrete runner designated and regulated by Wheatland County with or without a base in accordance with the dimension outlined in Schedule "A".

Under rules for Monument Design, Construction and Maintenance, regarding concrete runners Appendix A states:

No monument work, including memorial tablets, shall be allowed to a cemetery until the location for proposed, and the contractor is ready to proceed with erection and/or placement.



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
