

Introduction

From October 16 to November 8 2020, the County of Wheatland used a budget simulation exercise called Citizen Budget for their 2021 Operating and Capital Budget. The purpose of this program was to show residents where their tax dollars are being spent and allow them to increase or decrease the levels of service provided by the County. In addition, the program allowed residents to see these changes in service levels would raise or lower their taxes.

- The process educated residents on the County's various services, while asking them to provide feedback based on the County's current service levels and budget.
- Ethelo used the results to generate a particular set of funding changes that are predicted to have the most community support.




Funding Fire Services

• Increase: 41%




Funding Peace Officers

•Increase: 21%




Funding Agriculture and Environment*


Funding Parks and Recreation *


Funding Roads

Comments

Funding Parks and Recreation

"I am glad that the County has made a bigger effort to consider and provide recreation options. I would like to see an increased emphasis on this."

"At least 4 new play grounds this year. Playgrounds in Cluny and in a very odd place in Speargrass makes me think there could be better value if money was put into core services"

Funding Community Peace Officers

"It is disingenuous to suggest that taxes must be increased in order to improve service. The County had a \$3 000 000 operating surplus last year. And has an unrestricted accumulated surplus of \$19 000 000. **Taxes should not be collected from residents and then not used to provide services.**"

"Reduction in response times? Do they even respond to anything? Perhaps their role should be explained first! **They seem to be a waste of money**."

Funding Fire Services

"The County should **complete the Carseland Fire Hall** ASAP. There is \$5000000 in capital reserves for Fire Services. It is ridiculous to play around with fund-raising when taxpayer money is sitting in the bank designated to capital projects such as this."

Funding Roads

"Taking away the grader from Dalum and making the rest of the graders make up by doing a larger area as Council has planned for March of 2021 will result in **longer wait times to get snow plowed** ...It's winter here 6-7 months of the year. School buses and people going to work should not be delayed even more."

"To have several million dollars worth of iron sitting on the side of the road this summer because they wouldn't fund wages is an abomination. If you're going to refund construction do it over time and **make up the difference with reserves** to cover deficit"

"More dust control would be welcome, especially during long periods of dry weather and heavier traffic"

"I would like to see more dust control on the busy Township Roads especially during planting & harvesting season"

"I think that dust control should be included in the taxes. Particularly on busier range roads."

"Dust control is good but why do we have to pay extra for it"

"Skip dust control all together"



Do You Live in a Hamlet/ Village or in the County?*


What division do you live or own a property in?









What is your age group?




Gender*




How Long Have You Been Living In Wheatland County?*
