





October 4, 2022

- Council moved Second and Third reading of Bylaw 2022-10, this being a bylaw for the purpose of amending Land Use Bylaw No. 2016-01 to redesignate Block 1, Plan 871 1027, within E ½ 34-21-25-W4M from Agriculture General District to Natural Resource Extraction/Processing District.
- Council moved First Reading of Bylaw 2022-18, this being a bylaw for the purpose of amending Land Use Bylaw No. 2016-01 to redesignate ± 3.37 hectares (± 8.33 acres) within a portion of SE-21-25-W4M, from Agriculture General District to Hamlet Residential General District as shown on the attached Schedule 'A'.
- Council moved that a Public Hearing for Bylaw 2022-18 be scheduled for October 18, 2022, at 11:00 AM in Wheatland County Council Chambers.
- Council granted First, Second, Third and Final Reading of Bylaw 2022-21, Traffic Control Bylaw Schedule Amendment Bylaw, being a bylaw to amend Schedules A, B, and C, of Bylaw 2019-20.
- Council granted First, Second, Third and Final Reading of Bylaw 2022-22, being a bylaw for the purpose of amending Land Use Bylaw No. 2016-01 to remove Section 2: Calgary Metropolitan Region Board.
- THAT Council moved First, Second, Third and Final Reading of Bylaw 2022-26, being a bylaw for the purpose of revising Municipal Planning Commission and Subdivision Authority Bylaw No. 2018-11 in accordance with Wheatland County departmental restructuring, and amendments to the *Municipal Government Act*.
- Council directed Administration to schedule a meeting with K Division at the Fall RMA Convention to discuss hubbing and send a request to a Southern Alberta District Commander to present to Council.
- Council ratified attendance and mileage of Councillors who attended the De Havilland Announcement on September 21, 2022.
- Council accepted the October 4, 2022, Council Resolution Tracker as information.
- Council approved that a Wheatland County Committee of the Whole be scheduled to take place on November 15, 2022 to commence following the Municipal Planning Commission meeting.
- Council directed Administration to assist Councillors with community town hall events, up to 2 events per year.
- Council accepted the addition of the proposed Information Management Policy (section 4.4) to the Information, Security and Technology Policies.
