



- Council provided First, Second, Third, and Final Reading of Bylaw 2023-04, this being a Bylaw to authorize the imposition of a Community Aggregate Payment Levy on lands within Wheatland County.
- Council directed Administration to write a letter to the Wheatland Housing Management Body to confirm whether a hospice requisition is allowable under the Act.
- Council accepted the March 7, 2023, Council Resolution Tracker as information.
- Council declared June 5 11, 2023 to be Seniors' Week in Wheatland County, in honour of the past, present and future contributions of the seniors of this community and throughout Alberta.
- Council approved attendance for up to three Councillors at the 2023 Federation of Canadian Municipalities Convention in Toronto, Ontario from May 25-28, 2023.
- Councillor Biggar made a Notice of motion for the April 18, 2023, Regular Council Meeting "THAT 75% of the CAP Levy from Division 3 be put towards the pathways planned in the Division 3 area, which is being looked after or governed by the Wheatland Trails to the Bow Society."
- Council directed Administration to bring back the policy for the Community Aggregate Payment Levy to state more clearly that the funds go to the community in the division that the funds were collected at and that 75% of that levy can be used for community projects from that division.
- Council designated the communities of Lyalta and the Lakes of Muirfield as a hamlet, known as the 'Hamlet of Lyalta', as per the attached Schedule A, including the existing ball diamond and community hall, Hamlet Boundary Map.
- Council directed Administration to forward the briefing package on to Alberta Transportation and request a meeting with the Minister of Transportation.
- Council approved the naming of the Speargrass to Highway 24 connector road as 'Speargrass Boulevard'.
- Council directed Administration to collaborate with representatives of the Lakes of Muirfield HOA Board to
  find a permanent site in the Lakes of Muirfield and/or the Lyalta area for the immediate, mid-term and
  long-term recreational amenities for the residents of the Lakes of Muirfield and surrounding area as per the
  Open Space, Recreation & Culture Master Plan.
- The following motions arose from an in-camera session:
  - THAT Council approve renaming the campground located at 234036 Range Road 243 Wheatland Shores.
