



## Council Meeting



**October 17, 2023**

- Council undertook the scheduled Public Hearing and moved First, Second and Third Reading for Bylaw 2023- 22, this being a bylaw to amend Appendix A of Direct Control District 7, Development Cells Map, to redesignate a portion of the lands from Cell 9 – Future Residential Type 1 Development, to Cell 1 – Residential Type I, as show on the attached Schedule 'A' of the agenda, forming part of this Bylaw.
- Council undertook the scheduled Public Hearing and moved Second and Third Reading for Bylaw 2023-23, this being a bylaw for the purpose of amending Land Use Bylaw No. 2016-01 to redesignate Area K, Plan 9810989, from Agricultural General District to Rural Business District as shown on the attached Schedule 'A' of the agenda, forming part of this Bylaw.
- Council approved First, Second, Third, and Final Reading of Bylaw 2023-21, this being a bylaw to repeal Bylaw 2018-10, the Marigold Library System Loan.
- Council authorized the Reeve and Chief Administrative Officer sign the Termination Agreement between Marigold Library Board and Wheatland County.
- Council directed Administration to draft an RFD with some context for Council to consider regarding cost sharing with the Town of Drumheller.
- Council directed Administration to bring back a report on a system to track users of facilities.
- Council accepted the Council Resolution Tracker dated October 17, 2023, as information.
- Council directed Administration to bring a report to Council with more information on the debenture for Carseland/Speargrass and cost sharing for wastewater infrastructure utilization with Muirfield.
- Council directed Administration to increase utility rates by 7% for 2024 effective February 1, 2024 and by 7% for 2025 effective January 1, 2025 and update the Master Schedule of Fees bylaw.
- Council denied the request from Nutrien (Canada) Holdings ULC to cancel the 2023 tax penalty for various tax rolls.
- Council directed Administration to explore establishing a partnership with the Alberta Conservation Association concerning the Legacy Island at the Bow River.
- Council directed Administration to look into the possibility of snow removal at the Lyalta Community Hall with capacity and cost for future consideration.
- Council directed Administration to target Cheadle for enforcement and bring back data on the speed on those signs.
