	For: household garbage, furniture, mattresses, treated wood (MDF, particle board), bundled wire, sharps (needles, razors), plastics, and glass.	For: newsprint, cardboard, metal, electronics, batteries, bulbs, oil, oil filters and containers, antifreeze, propane tanks <100lbs., paint, bagged twine, tires, and Freon or regular appliances.	For: yard waste (grass, leaves, etc.), vegetable scraps, wood shavings, and hay/straw (small quantities). *Bags must be compostable.	For: trees and branches <10' in length, brush, clean lumber, and pallets. *No dirt, rocks, or treated wood.	For: household chemicals, automotive paints, and aerosol chemical sprays. *Must be labeled in a sealed container, and in quantities <20L.	*Ash must be at least 3 weeks old.
