



Council Meeting



May 2, 2023

- Council approved first reading of the Master Schedule of Fees Bylaw 2023-13, as amended to include new construction, single and family dwellings and duplexes.
- Council approved attendance and mileage for Division 1 Councillor and Division 3 Councillor at the FCSS Regional Conference on April 24, 2023.
- Council directed Administration to find out whether RMA insurance covers the vandalism that occurred at a County sponsored event.
- Council directed Administration to have DLA Piper come to the next scheduled Council meeting to report on resolution CM-2023-04-58 and the actions they have taken thus far.
- Council directed Administration to look into the development of Range Road 19-5 north of Highway 561, look into the costs and benefits and bring a report back to Council.
- Council accepted the May 2, 2023, Council Resolution Tracker as information.
- Council appointed Councillor Laursen as a Wheatland County representative to the Wheatland Housing Management Body (WHMB) for the remainder of the 2022/23 term.
- Council appointed Deputy Reeve Klassen as an alternate Wheatland County representative to the Wheatland Housing Management Body (WHMB) for the remainder of the 2022/23 term.
- Council approved changes to Human Resources Policy 6.3.1 – Extended Healthcare and Related Benefits in order to implement a two-year limit on health and dental benefits while employees are on long term disability (LTD) to align with comparable municipalities.
- Council approved changes to Human Resources Policy 6.3.3 - Local Authorities Pension Plan (LAPP) in order to remove the probationary period due to a change in legislation.
- Council ratified one day per diem and mileage for Councillor Ikert's attendance at the SAEWA Strategic Planning Session on April 21, 2023.
- Council approved the disposition of IT and office assets that are at the end of their life by silent auction in person and recycle any remaining assets after the auction.
- Council declined the utility account holder's request for a billing write-off at a property located in Gleichen, associated with utility account number 2100.10.
- Council approved and authorize the Reeve to sign the updated Wheatland Regional Emergency Management Agreement, which now includes the City of Chestermere as a participating member.
- Council directed Administration to bring a report back to Council listing community events held within the County where in-kind services (not financial contributions) could be provided by the County.
