

Subdivision and Development Appeal Board Notice of Appeal

In accordance with Sections 678, 685, and 686 of the *Municipal Government Act* and the Wheatland County Land Use Bylaw, an appeal to the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board must be filled within the legislated time frame. Each Notice of Appeal must be accompanied by payment of a non-refundable filing fee, as stated in the Master Fee Schedule.

The personal information is being collected in accordance with Section 33(c) of the *Alberta Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIP Act)* and will be protected under Part 2 of the Act. This form is intended for the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board and will be used to process your appeal and create a public record of the appeal hearing. 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Appeal Submission Information

For each Notice of Appeal form submitted a non-refundable filing fee is required for subdivision and development appeals. Please note, the Notice of Appeal form and the accompanying fee must be received by the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board (SDAB) no later than the final date for appeal as specified in the Municipal Government Act. What should your appeal form include?

The form should include your contact information, the property under appeal, and specific reasons supporting your appeal. You can submit additional documents such as site plan, photographs, etc. to support your appeal.

When will my appeal be heard?

Your appeal will be heard by the Board within 30 days from the date it has been received by the Board Clerk. You will be notified in writing of the date, time and place of the hearing. The Board Clerk will notify neighbouring parcels (if applicable) and the notice of the hearing will be posted on the County website and in local newspapers.
